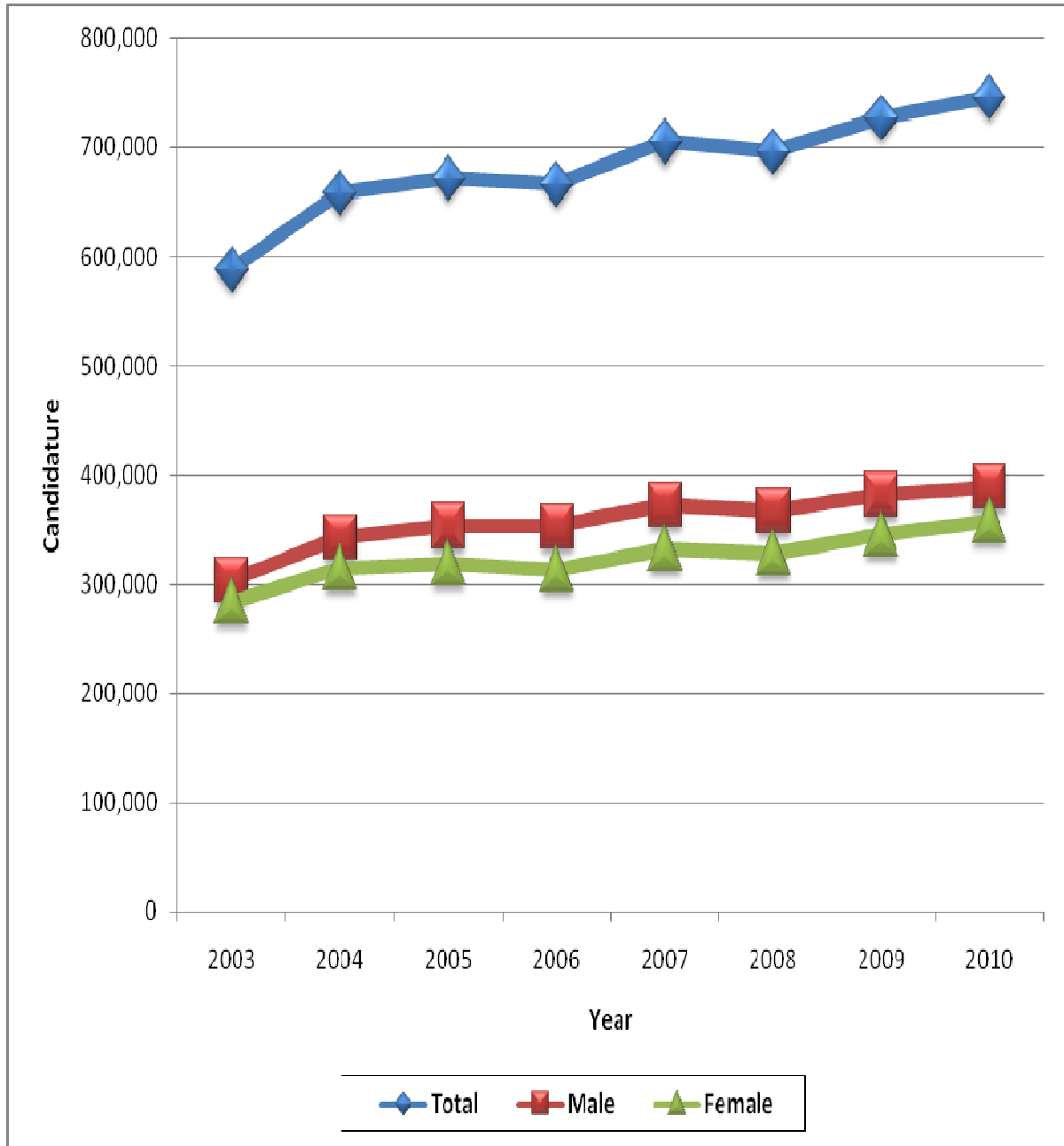

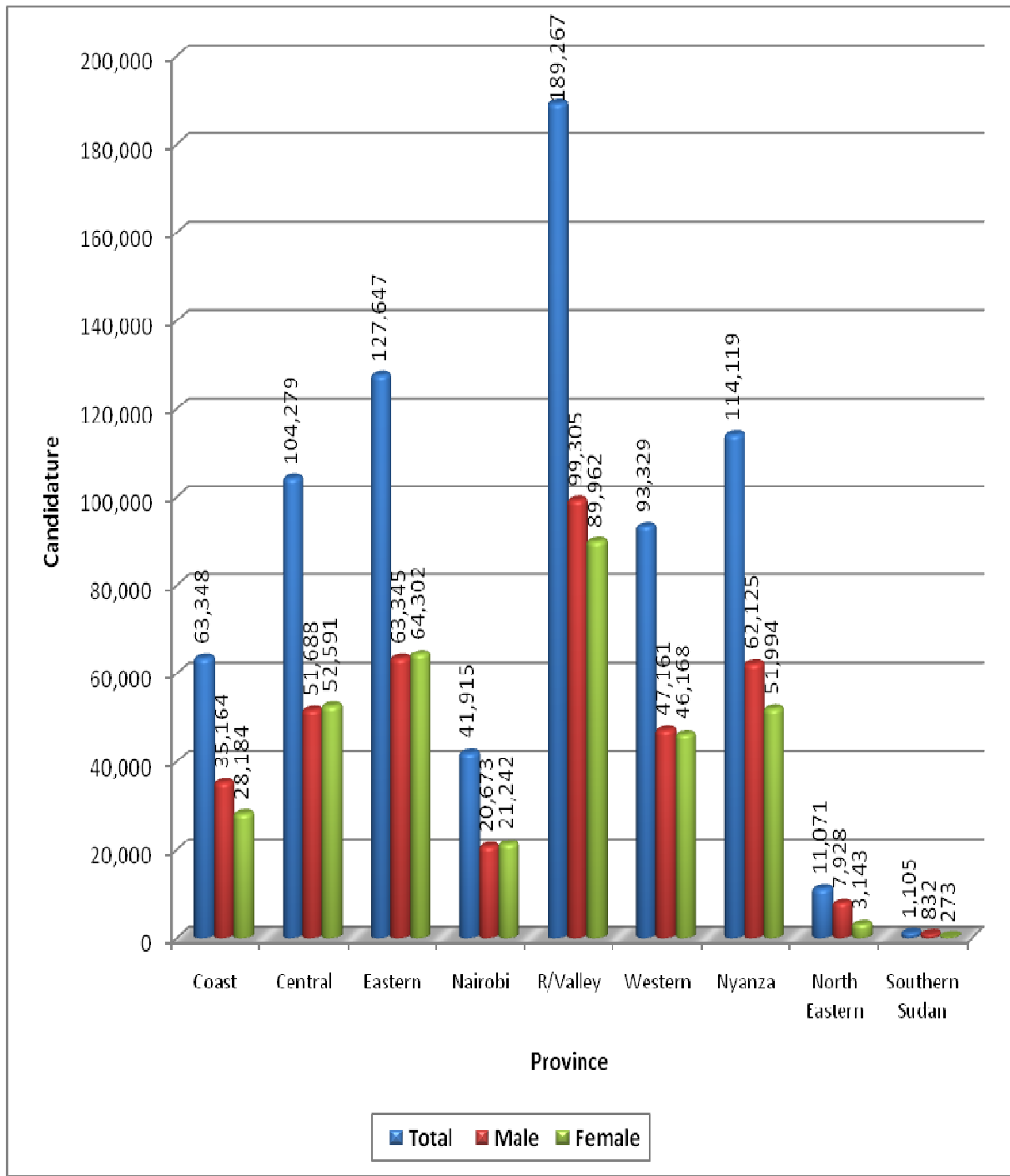
2.0 GRAPH 1: KCPE EXAMINATION CANDIDATURE TRENDS SINCE 2003

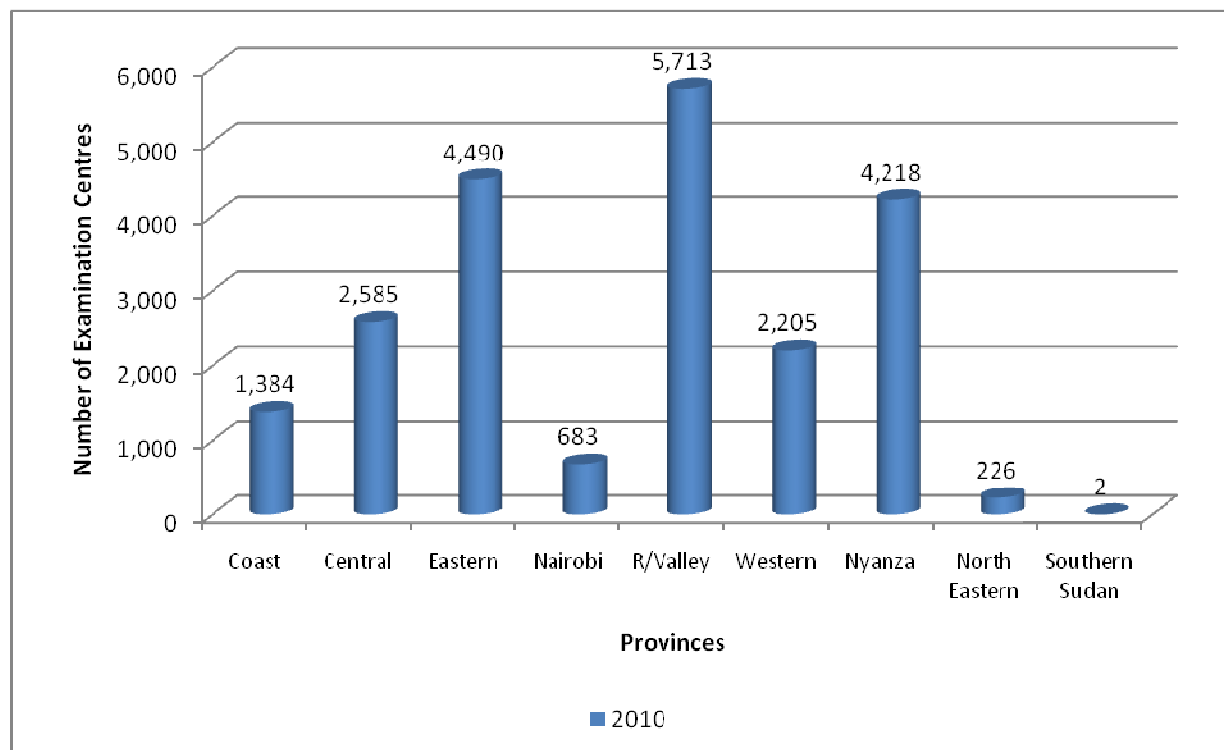
4.0 GRAPH 2: YEAR 2010 KCPE EXAMINATION CANDIDATURE BY PROVINCE
